

The Corporation of the Village of Newbury

By-law Number 115-2007

**Being a By-law to regulate or prohibit animals
from running at large and to provide for impounding
all animals not permitted to run at large.**

SECTION 1 – DEFINITIONS

In this by-law:

“**Animal:** - shall mean any horse, swine, horned or other cattle, sheep, goat, poultry, chicken, geese, or other fowl or any other animal or bird kept as a pet or for any other purpose.

“**Animal Control Officer**” – shall mean a person duly appointed by the Corporation of the Village of Newbury for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of the municipal by-law.

“**Council**” – shall mean the Council of the Village of Newbury.

“**Municipality**” – shall mean the Corporation of the Village of Newbury.

“**Owner**” – includes any person who possesses or harbors any animal.

“**Owens or Owned**” – shall have a corresponding meaning.

“**Police Officer**” – shall be a police officer including a police officer within the meaning of the Police Services Act.

“**Provincial Offenses Officer/By-law Officer**” – shall be any one appointed by the Village of Newbury to enforce set regulation,

“**Pound**” – shall be the location or locations designated from time to time for the keeping of the stray animals.

“**Pound Keeper**” – shall be a person appointed by the Municipality for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of the municipal by-law and the Pounds Act R.S.O.

SECTION 2

2 – POUNDS

The Council of the Municipality shall appoint a Pounds Keeper to carry out the provisions of the Pounds Act R.S.O.

**SECTION 3
PROHIBITED MATTERS**

3 – PROHIBITED MATTERS RELATED TO ANIMALS

No person shall suffer or permit any animal of which he or she is the owner or custodian to run at large or trespass on any property in the Village of Newbury.

4 – ANIMALS AT LARGE

For the purpose of this by-law, an animal shall be deemed at large when found on any highway or other public place or on any property without the consent of the owner of the property and not in the charge of any person.

5 – MEASURES TO PROHIBIT FROM RUNNING AT LARGE

Every person who is the owner or custodian of any animal(s) deemed to be running at large, shall take immediate measures to prohibit the said animals from running at large

6 – SEIZURE

6.1 The Animal Control Officer, the Pound Keeper, the By-law Officer or any Police Officer may seize any animal found at large contrary to any provisions contained in this by-law.

6.2 It shall be the duty of the Pound Keeper to impound any animal seized by him or a person mentioned in 5.1 or delivered to him in accordance with the Pounds Act R.S.O. 1990.

7 – PENALTY SECTION

7.1 Every Person who contravenes any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine as provided in the Provincial Offences Act.

7.2 The Court in which the conviction has been entered, and any court of competent jurisdiction thereafter, may make an order prohibiting the continuation or repetition of the offence by the person convicted, and such order shall be in addition to any other penalty imposed on the person convicted.

8 – TARIFF OF FEES AND CHARGES - Pounds - Schedule “A”

Fees and charges in Schedule “A” hereto annexed, is established by this by-law.

9 – TARIFF OF FEES AND CHARGES – Rounding Up – Schedule “B”

Fees and charges in Schedule “B” hereto annexed, is established by this by-law.

10 – FORCE AND EFFECT

This by-law comes into force and effect on the date of final passing.

READ a first and second time this 11th day of July, 2007.

READ a third time and finally passed this 11th day of July, 2007.
