



Notice – As of March 17th, 2020

Please be advised that on Tuesday, March 17th at 3:00, Diane Brewer, Reeve of the Village of Newbury signed, as required, a Declaration of Emergency as did the County of Middlesex, the Province of Ontario and the other seven municipalities in Middlesex. This declaration is in efforts to contain the spread of the COVID-19 virus.

The Municipal Services Office front door will be open so that you can enter to pick up your mail. The Post Office roll up door will be closed and products not sold until further notice. If you have a parcel to pick up arrangements will be made for you (knock on the door for assistance).

I will meet with residents for emergency purposes and by appointments only. If you have access to the internet please email me your questions or concerns or call the office.

As per Dr. Chris Mackie, Medical Officer of Health has told us *“our community is at a critical phase in its response to COVID-19, when any steps that reduce social contact have the potential to help stem the spread of virus.”* Therefore, office staff regularly clean all surfaces, handles, etc. daily for your safety and ours.
