



ADVERTISEMENT

The Corporation of the Village of Newbury, County of Middlesex is soliciting interested Operations Service Companies to submit their interest and proposal for the operation of the Village's Wastewater Treatment Facilities (WWTF) and Water Distribution System (WDS).

The Village intends to select an operations services contractor by the following prescribe method:

1. Operations Services Companies (Proponents) will be solicited through public advertisement and direct contact requesting they make a Submission (Proposal) through this (RFI) Request for Interest.
2. The RFI package is divided into two (2) parts, the Submission of Interest (Proposal) and the Request for Quotation (Pricing).
3. Only those companies (Successful Proponents) who have made a full Submission and deemed to be qualified by the Village will then be asked to submit their pricing for a (5) five year service agreement.
4. The Operation Service Company (Selected Proponent) which is recommended by the selection team and approved by the village of Newbury will negotiate the final service agreement with the Village.

The RFI process will include a mandatory site visits at the Villages Wastewater Plant, 37 Wellington street commencing at 11:00 AM on the 28 of August 2018.

Interested parties should know that the Village intends to fast tract the selection process as the existing Services Agreement for the Newbury Operations Services expires on November 30. 2018
