One-Time payment of \$161,095- to support small and rural municipalities' efforts to become more efficient and reduce expenditures in a municipality and while this is unconditional, it is intended to help modernize service delivery and reduce future costs through investments in projects such as service delivery reviews, development of shared services agreements and capital investments. List provided at meeting. Council reviewed the list and added a few suggestions. The Clerk will provide costs at the next meeting if she has them available.
